



GROUP WATER POLICY - BEVERAGES

Water is a very precious resource; essential for life and wellbeing. Coca-Cola Amatil Limited (CCA) uses water from metropolitan supplies for our beverage production and natural spring and mineral sources for our water bottling business.

CCA has a role to play in the management of our water sources and we aim to lead industry by our actions. Water is vital to our business and we will use it in a responsible and sustainable manner.

To this end, we will:

- Through our Environmental Management Systems, seek to continuously improve efficiency of water use in our production facilities;
- Set annual water efficiency targets to ensure we remain amongst the most efficient water users in the Coca-Cola system and the broader beverage industry;
- Responsibly dispose of wastewater from all operations within legal limits and seek to minimise both the quantity and any hazardous nature of all effluent;
- Maintain open dialogue with governments, non-government organisations and local communities about water resource management;
- Maintain site management plans in accordance with our Quality and Environmental Management Systems for mineral and spring water sources, taking into consideration the hydrogeological aspects of each source, their zones of influence, sustainability and use; and
- Confirm the sustainability of a source prior to it being used for any mineral or spring water for CCA products;
